Penguins and Cubs	We will be learning words with short a, ar (cat, cart, mat, mart)

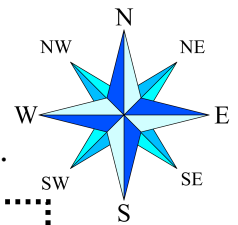
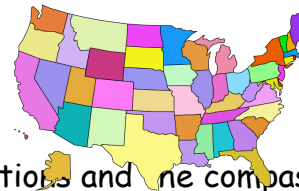
Reading Workshop: We will be wondering and questioning various texts. We will also be self monitoring while we are reading.
